Responsibilities:

The primary responsibility of the Middle School and Primary School Teacher is to deliver and promote a strong English program within the primary years at the School.

General

Teachers should ensure:

- Their delivery of the curriculum caters for students with varying learning styles and ensures best practice in pedagogy in English ESL
- They keep up-to-date with modern teaching practice...the school expounds the “Explicit Teaching - I Do, We Do, You Do’ model of early years pedagogy.
- They use appropriate learning styles for ESL students
- That they use a variety of assessment tasks for students to experience success and accurately assess and build levels of student achievement
- They attend relevant school promotional activities to help build the Haileybury Tianjin community.

Co-curricular responsibilities

- Teachers are expected to participate in co-curricular activities including sport, the arts and/or outdoor activities.
